George Cross was born in Essex, England, Feb. 6, 1856, and died at Colfax, Ia., March 11, 1917, aged 61 years, 1 month and 11 days. He was married to Eliza Dudderidge in London, England, in 1880. He came to Des Moines, Ia., in 1883, and from there to Grinnell, Ia., in 1885, where he has lived almost continuously up to the time of his death.

He was a member of the Modern Woodmen of America, Camp 291, Grinnell, Ia. He has worked at his trade as a baker since he was 14 years old. He leaves to mourn his loss his wife, who is at the present time in a state institution for treatment; also his twin brother Edward of Boone, Ia.; and one sister, Mrs. J. F. Macauley of Glasgow, Scotland.
