

Gilman pastor services held

The Rev. Donald T. Cutler, 64, of Gilman died Thursday morning, Oct. 30, at Marshalltown Area Community Hospital.

Funeral services were conducted at 1:30 p.m. Saturday at the Gilman United Methodist Church, with the Rev. Donald Scheller officiating. Burial was at Prairie View Cemetery, Gilman with the Avery Funeral Home in charge of arrangements.

The son of Charles and Ida Kesterson, he was born Dec. 5, 1915, at Sioux City. He graduated from Whiting High School and attended John Fletcher College in Oskaloosa and the Asbury Seminary in Wilmore, Ky.

The Rev. Mr. Cutler served pastorates in Iowa for 35 years, including the United Methodist churches at Laurel and Gilman. He was married Oct.

17, 1943, to Arlene Hindman in Winterset.

Survivors include his wife; two sons, Gary Cutler of Waverly and David Cutler of Gilman; a daughter, Carol Hinderaker of Radcliffe; two sisters, Bernice Yacevich of Sioux City and Maxine Eidem of St. Helen, Ore.; a brother, Carl Cutler of Bloomington, Ill.; and four grandchildren.
