David E. Daehler, 51, of Rte. 1, Kellogg, died of cancer Wednesday, June 14, at Grinnell General Hospital.

The body was cremated. A memorial service was conducted Friday at Reese Chapel in Newton, with the Rev. Jerry Brown officiating. A private interment service was held.

The son of Ferdinand and Effie Maytag Daehler, he was born Oct. 7, 1937, in Cook County, Ill. He attended Boone and Newton schools. He lived for 17 years in Boone before moving to Newton.

Mr. Daehler was a production worker in the Maytag Co.'s Porcelain Department. He had been on medical leave since February of this year.

He was a member of the First United Methodist Church, the Moose Lodge, and United Auto Workers Local 997 of Newton.

Surviving are one son, David of Waterloo; a daughter, Diane Vermillion of Charles City; two grandchildren; and one brother, John of Newton. He was preceded in death by his parents.
