## Betty Jean Dale Services Thursday

Betty Jean Dale, 36, wife of Robert Dale, of Rte. 1, Grinnell, passed away Monday evening at St. Francis Hospital here, following a serious illness of the last six years.

She was born July 21, 1931, in Grinnell, the daughter of George H. and Aletha Grimm Heinle. She was one of seven children. She attended the local schools, graduating with the Class of 1948 from Grinnell High School. On Nov. 14, 1952, she was united in marriage with Robert Dale, and to this union were born three sons, all of whom reside at the family home.

Mrs. Dale had lived in the Grinnell area all of her life. She was a member of the First Baptist Church and the Homemakers Club. She was a teacher of Sunday School.

She was preceded in death by her sister, Myrna Heinle, in 1963, and her father, George Heinle, on Sept. 9, 1967, two days prior to her own death.
