

Floyd Dale ^{H-R} ^{August 14,} rites held ¹⁹⁷⁸

Funeral services for Floyd Dale, 88, formerly of Grinnell, were held last Monday (Aug. 7) in McAllen, Tex.

Mr. Dale died Aug. 4 at the Veterans' hospital in Kerrville, Tex.

The son of William and Electce Alley Dale, he was born and raised in Poweshiek County and attended Grinnell High School and Grinnell College. After his graduation from the School of Mines at El Paso, Tex., he became a mining engineer. Following his mining career, he retired to raise citrus fruit in McAllen, Tex.

Mr. Dale was also a veteran of World War I.

He was preceded in death by his father and mother; a daughter, Nadine Ball; and four brothers, Brandon, David, Orville, and Bryan.

Survivors include his wife Ruby; two sons, Joe of McAllen and John of Dallas, Tex.; two brothers, George of Deep River and Thomas O. of McAllen; and seven grandchildren.

The Rev. William Hathaway of McAllen and V.F.W. Post 2369 conducted services at Mr. Dale's grave at Valley Memorial Gardens in McAllen.
