Cora Inez Davis 97, of Russellville, Ark., the widow of Manfred D. Davis, died January 17 in Russellville.

Graveside services for Mrs. Davis will be held at 10 a.m. Saturday at Ivy Hill Cemetery, Malcom, with the Rev. John Maze, pastor of the Malcom Community Church, officiating. Her ashes will be buried in Ivy Hill Cemetery, with the Smith Funeral Home in charge of arrangements. Following their marriage, Mr. and Mrs. Davis lived in and near Malcom, where Mr. Davis was a rural mail carrier. Following Mr. Davis' retirement in 1935, they moved to St. Cloud, Fla. Mr. Davis died in December of 1938, and Mrs. Davis continued to make her home in St. Cloud until 1966, when she began spending time with each of her daughters. In June of 1974, she moved to Russellville to live with her daughter Leda. She was a member of the United Methodist Church.
