

Emma Davis Rites Pending

Emma G. Davis, 82, a resident of the Mayflower Home, died Wednesday morning, May 22, at the Mayflower Health Center, following an extended illness.

The daughter of Ernst and Katrina Boos Guenther, she was born Jan. 24, 1892, at DePue, Ill., and received her education in the schools of that community. She lived in DePue until she was 15, then moved to Kewanee, Ill.

On June 10, 1912, she was married to Raymond Davis at Kewanee. The couple had one daughter, Shirley May, who died during her second year in high school in 1937. Mr. Davis also preceded her in death on July 9, 1948.

Following the death of her husband, Mrs. Davis lived in Kewanee for two years, then moved to Davenport where she lived for four years. She moved to LaSalle, Ill., to care for a niece for 1½ years, then returned to Davenport. On Nov. 24, 1961, she moved to Grinnell to live at the Mayflower Home.

She was a member of the United Church of Christ-Congregational.

Mrs. Davis is survived by two sisters, Mrs. James Dwyre of Spring Valley, Ill., and Mrs. Freeman Wilson of Chicago. She was preceded in death by her husband, her parents, two brothers who died in infancy, and five sisters.

Funeral services for Mrs. Davis are pending, and friends may call the James-Schalinske Funeral Home for information. Burial will be in the Pleasant View Cemetery at Kewanee.
