

Davis rites held Dec. 17

Frank Dwight Davis, 69, of Cedar Rapids, died in University Hospitals in Iowa City on Wednesday, Dec. 14, following a long illness.

Funeral services for Frank D. Davis were held on Saturday, Dec. 17, at 1:30 p.m. at the Trinity Lutheran Church by Pastor Richard L. Thompson, pastor of the church. Burial was at Cedar Memorial Cemetery in Cedar Rapids.

Born on Jan. 28, 1908 in Grinnell, he lived in Cedar Rapids most of his life. He attended Grinnell public

schools until his junior year in high school, and completed his secondary education in Cedar Rapids.

He married Edith Hunter, formerly of Grinnell, in Cedar Rapids on April 19, 1933. Penick and Ford employed Davis in their factory personnel for 45 years.

He is survived by his wife; a daughter, Barbara Kern of Midland, Mich.; a son, the Rev. Larry Davis of Modena, Wis.; a sister, Ruby McGinty of Cedar Rapids; and a brother, Will Davis, of Cedar Rapids.
