Gail Davis rites are held

Gail Davis, 87, of Gilman died Sunday, April 10, at a Kingsland, Texas, nursing home.

Graveside services were conducted at 10:30 a.m. Wednesday at the Prairie View Cemetery, Gilman, with the Rev. Stephen G. Miller pastor of the Gilman Community Church, officiating.

She was the daughter of Charles and Maude Hall Kinton and was born Sept. 10, 1900, at Pollock, Mo., where she attended school. She was married to Clovie Davis Nov. 28, 1917, at Unionville, Mo. The couple lived near Unionville

for seven years before coming to a farm near Laurel in 1924. Mrs. Davis had been a Gilman resident since 1926. She was a member of the Gilman community church.
