**Keith Davis services held**

Keith W. Davis, 59, Malcom postmaster, died Saturday, June 16, at Iowa Methodist Medical Center in Des Moines.

Funeral services were conducted at 1:30 p.m. Tuesday at the Watts Funeral Home in Montezuma, with the Revs. Glenn Hulsebus and Gerald Brown officiating. Music was by Darrell Brand, soloist, and Tom Sandholm, organist. Pallbearers were David Goin, Donald Davis, Glenn Cruchelow, Thomas Davis, Dale Cheuvront and Dallas Cruchelow.

Burial was in the Friends Cemetery at Lynnvile.

The son of Kelly and Jessie Ratcliff Davis, he was born May 14, 1925, at Searsboro. He graduated from Searsboro High School in 1942. He enlisted in the U.S. Army in 1944 and served overseas during World

War II.

On Feb. 20, 1948, he was married to Margaret Geer near Malcom. They farmed near Montezuma, Searsboro and Brooklyn before moving to a farm near Malcom in 1962. Mr. Davis had served as Malcom postmaster since 1967.

He was a member of the Ewart Presbyterian Church where he had served as chairman of the trustees for several years.

Survivors include his wife, Margaret; three daughters, Karen Johnson of Marathon, Cheryl Berry of Montezuma and Ruth Davis of Council Bluffs; four grandchildren; his mother, Jessie Davis of Montezuma; and one brother.

He was preceded in death by his father and an infant son, Charles Arnold.
