WENDALL W. DAVIS

Wendall W. "Bing" Davis, 75, of Thornburg, died Friday, Jan. 8, 1988, at Mahaska County Hospital in Oskaloosa.

Born May 31, 1912, at Thornburg, he was a lifelong resident of that town. The son of Abel and Maggie Mae Smith Davis, he was a brick mason by trade.
