Sorrow has been brought to many friends in Grinnell by the death of Mrs. Lucia Howland Day, well remembered here as a Grinnell girl and a graduate of the high school and college. She graduated from the college at the age of 19 years and aught in the public schools of Fairmount and Sherburn, Minn., until her marriage to Frank A. Day in 1883.
