

Anna C. DeCamp Funeral Rites Slated Today

Anna Catherine DeCamp of Grinnell died Monday evening at a local hospital following a lingering illness.

Funeral services were held today (Thursday) at 2:00 p.m. from the James Funeral Home with Dr. G. S. Bruland of the Methodist church officiating. Organ music was furnished by Mrs. Kathleen Heffner.
