

Last Rites Monday For Mrs. DeGeeter

Mrs. Clemance De Geeter, 83, a Brooklyn resident for 19 years, died last Friday at St. Francis hospital in Grinnell following a three-week illness.

Funeral services were held Monday morning at St. Patrick's church with the Rev. John T. Kennedy officiating at the ten o'clock requiem mass. Interment was in Calvary cemetery with Remi Wauters, Henry Arens, Peter DeCorte, Henry DeRycke, Guy Dixon and Clarence Possehl serving as pallbearers. Mr. and Mrs. Dale Lippincott were in charge of flowers.

The daughter of Peter and Florence DeCraene, Mrs. De Geeter was born at Eeklo, Belgium, Sept. 28, 1881, and died October 2, 1964.

She was married to Kamiel DeGeeter in 1911 in Belgium and the couple came to the United States. They lived on a farm near Hartwick until 1945 when they retired and moved into Brooklyn. Mr. DeGeeter died in June, 1953.

Mrs. DeGeeter is survived by two sons, Julian DeGeeter of Hartwick and Maurice DeGeeter of Brooklyn. She also leaves five grandchildren.

Other survivors include four brothers. They are August DeCraene of Robsart, Canada, Camiel DeCraene of Ormond Beach, Fla., Fred DeCraene of Brooklyn and Richard DeCraene of St. Petersburg, Fla. One sister and two brothers preceded her in death.
