Harold DeJong rites Tuesday

Harold F. DeJong, 67, of Kellogg died Saturday, Dec. 24, at Veterans Administration Hospital in Knoxville.

Funeral services were conducted at 1:30 p.m. Tuesday at the Wallace-Pence Funeral Home in Newton, with burial in Mount Zion Cemetery, rural Newton.

A native of Sully, Mr. DeJong retired as a security guard at Maytag Co. in 1983. He had farmed in Jasper County and was employed by the Sully Cooperative and the Jasper County assessor's office.
