John Elvin Dean, 69, of Exline, the brother of Richard E. Dean of Grinnell, died Thursday, April 16, at the Veterans Administration Hospital in Iowa City.

Funeral services were conducted Saturday at the Lange Funeral Home in Centerville, with the Rev. Carl Heien officiating. Burial was in Hilltown Cemetery south of Moulton.

The son of Henry and Rebecca Jane LaRue Dean, he was born May 25, 1922, near Coatsville, Mo. He was a graduate of Livonia High School and had been employed by the Herman Nelson Co. and Allis Chalmers.
