

Mrs. Decatur rites Tuesday

Mildred M. Decatur, 94, died Saturday evening, Nov. 28, at Friendship Manor where she had lived since 1978.

Graveside services will be conducted at 10 a.m. Tuesday at Hazelwood Cemetery, with the Rev. Raymond Lott, pastor of the Grinnell United Methodist Church, officiating.

She was born on June 1, 1893, in Hiawatha, Neb., the daughter of Simon and Lulu Jones Small. The family left Nebraska for Lynnville and later Grinnell where she graduated from Grinnell High School.
