Albert H. Deppe Dies At Home

Albert H. Deppe, 64, of Rte. 2, Kellogg, died suddenly Saturday, March 28, at his farm home near Rock Creek Lake of an apparent heart condition.

The son of Ernest and Augusta Bruhn Deppe, Mr. Deppe was born Sept. 3, 1905, in Rock Creek Township in Jasper County, Iowa. He lived all of his life on the farm where he was born.

Mr. Deppe was a member of St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Kellogg.

Survivors include his brother Herman of Rte. 2, Kellogg, and a number of nieces and nephews.

Mr. Deppe was preceded in death by his parents; three brothers—William, Fred and Henry Deppe, and a sister in infancy, Minnie Freida Deppe.

Funeral services for Mr. Deppe will be held at 1:30 p.m. Tuesday, March 31, at St. Paul's Lutheran church in Kellogg with the Rev. W. H. Lindquist, minister of the church, officiating.

Burial will be in the Kellogg Lutheran Cemetery.
