Loren W. Deppe, 72, of Rte. 2, Kellogg, died Friday, Sept. 28, at Grinnell General Hospital.

Funeral services were conducted Tuesday at the Wallace-Pence Funeral Home in Newton, with the Rev. Lyle Johnston, pastor of the Kellogg United Methodist Church, officiating. Burial was in Our Silent City Cemetery, Kellogg.
