6-17 Harry Dexter. 1919

Harry Dexter was born at Nottingham, England, Oct. 22, 1836, and died near Grinnell, Iowa, June 12, 1919, aged 82 years, 7 months and 20 days.

On September 26, 1874, he was married to Margaret Belle, of Chicago. Thirteen children were born to them, nine of whom survive to mourn his death. They are Edith Long of Oska-loosa, Iowa; Harry Frank, Clinton, Ill.; Robert F., Joseph I. and Charles E., of Grinnell; Rev Walter Dexter of Boston, Mass., Mrs. Ernest Ervin, Mrs. Lloyd Blackford and M. W. Dexter of Tokeman, Missouri.

Mr. Dexter was a member of the Church of England and always maintained his interest and devotion to the church of his youth. However, while in good health he always attended and contributed to the support of the local church believing that every community was the richer because of a religious atmosphere. His life was an example of patience, faith, courage and endurance.

Funeral services were held at the family residence in Oak Grove conducted by Rev. J. M. Brown. The body was taken to Tokeman, Mo., for burial.
