Wm. Dietrich Is Called By Death

Wm. Dietrich, well-known farmer of Lincoln township, died at 11:40 on Saturday night at the hospital in Williamsburg, following an operation. He had gone to the hospital the day before and was operated on for an abscess in his side Friday. The operation revealed a condition of blood poisoning which medical skill could not check.

Mr. Dietrich was the eldest son of Ferdinand and Caroline Dietrich and was born June 2, 1887, on the home farm in Lincoln township. Here he grew to manhood, was educated and engaged in farming.
