EVALENA DILLON

Mrs. Evalena K. Dillon, 93, or rural Brooklyn, died Thursday afternoon, April 27 in Brookhaven Nursing Home following a short illness. Funeral services for Mrs. Dillon were held at 1:30 p.m., Saturday, April 29, in the Nevenhoven Funeral Home, Brooklyn. Rev. Timothy Fletcher,

Pastor of the Church of the Brethren officiated. The organist was Mrs. Marilyn Kriegel. Casket-bearers were Brandon Miller, Matthew Miller, Jerrod Miller, Kevin Heishman, Stephen Heishman and Tim Heishman. Interment was in the Brooklyn Cemetery.

Evalena Kathryn Heishman Fraker Dillon, daughter of Gustus and Bettie Miller Heishman, was born August 8, 1901, on a farm northeast of Brooklyn. She received her education in a rural school. In 1920 she was united in marriage to Russell Fraker who died in 1949. On June 23, 1951, she was united in marriage to Hugh Dillon who died January 24, 1967.

She lived most of her life on the farm near Brooklyn. In June of 1992 she went to Friendship Manor, Grinnell, where she lived for six months and then became a resident at the Brookhaven Nursing Home in Brooklyn.

Mrs. Dillon was a member of the Church of the Brethren where she played the piano for many years.

Surviving are one brother, Wayne Heishman and his wife, Dorothy, of LaCrosse, Wis.; also a sister-in-law, Mrs. Margaret Heishman of Brooklyn; five nephews, Darrell Heishman, Maynard Heishman, and Virgil Heishman, all of Brooklyn, Richard Heishman of Hastings, Neb., and John Heishman of Des Plaines, Ill.; and one niece, Doris Rinniker of West Salem, Wis. Mrs. Dillon was preceded in death by her parents, her husbands, a brother, Delmar Heishman, and a nephew, Donald Heishman.
