Funeral services for W. H. Ditzler, aged 68, who passed away at his home at 1129 Hamlin street Wednesday night from a stroke of apoplexy, will be held from the home Saturday afternoon at 2:30 o'clock, conducted by Rev. A. B. Cadwell. Pallbearers will be Charles Budd, William McDowell, Ross V. Coutts, Paul Sloan, Charles Horak and Henry Lemke. Interment will be in Hazelwood cemetery.

William Henry Harrison Ditzler was born August 25, 1862, and was 68 years, 7 months and 6 days of age. He was born in the Westfield neighborhood and lived his entire life in Grinnell and vicinity with the exception of six months when he and Mrs. Ditzler lived in Gilman.

Besides Mrs. Harriet Ditzler, his widow, he is survived by one son, J. H. Ditzler, of Marshalltown, a brother, David of this city, and a sister, Mrs. Lou Lord of Marshalltown.

Mr. Ditzler had been feeling extra well the afternoon of the day he passed away. He had visited friends downtown and had also accompanied his son to Gilman on a business trip. He was feeling in the best of spirits during the evening and had gone into another room of the house when Mrs. Ditzler heard him fall.
