

## Robert H. Dodge

Robert H. Dodge, 81, of the Mayflower died of Alzheimer's disease Tuesday, Jan. 15, at the Mayflower Health Care Center.

A private family memorial service will be held at a later date. There will be no visitation. The Smith Funeral Home is in charge of arrangements.

He was born July 15, 1919, in Manhattan, Kan., and was the son of Fred and Myrtle Hutto Dodge. He was raised in Manhattan and graduated from high school there. He received a B.A. degree in business from Kansas State University. He served with the U.S. Army Air Corps during World War II.

On July 8, 1944, he was married to Mary Jo Dearstyne in Denver, Colo., where Mr. Dodge worked in the accounting department of Mountain Bell Telephone Co. He retired in 1985 and moved to the Mayflower in Grinnell in 1998.

While living in Denver, Mr. Dodge was a member of St. George's Episcopal Church and the Civitan service club. He attended St. Paul's Episcopal Church in Grinnell.

Surviving are his wife; three daughters, Leslie Czechowski of St. Paul, Minn., Stephanie Dodge of Sacramento, Calif., and Susan Hollister Dodge of New York City; two grandchildren; and one great-grandson. He was preceded in death by his parents.
