

CHESTER WOMAN GOES TO REWARD

Funeral Services, Conducted by Rev.
H. L. Wissler, were Held Wed-
nesday.

Katherine Josephine Jacobs was
born in Schleswig, Germany, on Feb-
ruary 16th., 1854 and died at the home
of her son, William Dohrn, near
Springville, Iowa, September 1st, 1924,
aged 70 years, 6 months, and 15 days.

July 10, 1886 she was united in mar-
riage to John Dohrn in Germany. Six
sons and two daughters were born to
this union. Those living are: Wil-
liam Dohrn, of Springville; and Mrs.
Lou Crawford of Chester.

Mr. and Mrs. Dohrn and family
came to America in 1882. They first
settled in Lyons, Iowa. Fourteen
years ago they came to Chester. Here
Mr. Dohrn passed away October 7th,
1916.

Mrs. Dohrn from youth was a mem-
ber of the Lutheran church. Her faith
in this church was confirmed when
she was quite young.

Short funeral services were held at
Springville by the old pastor of the
Lutheran Church. The body was
brought to the Crawford home in
Chester, where funeral services were
held on Wednesday afternoon and the
body was laid to rest in the Gilman
Cemetery. Rev. H. L. Wissler, of the
Chester Church, was in charge of the
services.
