## Leukemia claims life of Desireé Dontje

Desireé Dontje, 18, whose battle with leukemia prompted several local organizations to hold fund-raisers in her behalf, died of the disease Tuesday, Sept. 14, at University Hospitals in Iowa City.

Funeral services will be at 10:30 a.m. Saturday at the Grinnell Christian Church, with the Rev. Arvid Dixen, pastor of St. John's Lutheran Church, officiating. Burial will be in Hazelwood Cemetery.

She received the Fine Arts Award from the Department of Education at GTE and was a recipient of the P.E.O. Scholarship. She had worked part time at Village Decorating and as a lifeguard at the Grinnell Municipal Pool where she taught swimming and Red Cross.
