LJ Duey, 68, Waverly, formerly of Grinnell, died Monday at Iowa Methodist Medical Center of respiratory problems. June 20

Funeral services were held Thursday morning at the United Methodist Church in Waverly with burial in Harlington Cemetery, Waverly. Memorials may be made to the American Lung Association or Trinity United Methodist Church.

He was born Nov. 4, 1919, in Graham, Mo. He lived near Sharpsburg and Clearfield, graduating from Clearfield High School in 1937. He graduated from Iowa State College, Ames, in 1942.
