CECIL S. DUNCAN

Cecil S. Duncan was born April 15th, 1889 in Banner County, Neb., and died at a Grinnell hospital on December 23rd, 1955 following a lingering illness. H-R Dec 29, 1955

The son of Thomas and Ellen Judd Duncan, his family moved to Lineville, Iowa when he was seven years old. He received his education in that vicinity and in 1929 moved to Grinnell. He spent the remainder of his life in Grinnell and surrounding communities.
