Dwight Dunham Rites Wednesday

Dwight M. Dunham, 85, of Rte. 2, Grinnell, passed away Saturday at a local hospital, following an extended illness.

The son of Edward C. and Hannah Mann Dunham, he was born Sept. 22, 1882, at Grinnell. In 1896 his parents moved to Granett, Ark., and later to Gilmore City, Ia., where he graduated from high school. He later returned to Grinnell and attended the Grinnell Academy. In 1907 he homesteaded land at Scottsbluff, Neb., later moving to Akin, Minn., where he farmed until two years ago when he returned to the Grinnell Community. He lived here with his sister, Mrs. Ben Buck, on a farm southwest of Grinnell.

He was a member of the United Church of Christ — Congregational.

Mr. Dunham is survived by his brother Robert of Scottsbluff, Neb.; his sister Mrs. Mary F. (Ben) Buck of Grinnell; a niece, Mrs. Margaret (Wade) Hamor of Lincoln, Neb., his cousins Grinnell Dunham of Grinnell and Marian Dunham of Des Moines, and other cousins living away from here.

He was preceded in death by his parents in 1943 and a nephews, Edward Hannay.

Memorial services for Mr. Dunham will be Wednesday at 10:30 a.m. at the James-Schalinske Funeral Home. The Rev. Newell E. Davis will officiate.

A memorial has been established at the United Church of Christ — Congregational — for Mr. Dunham.
