Memorial services for Mrs. A. L. Eddy, who passed away Aug. 25 in Tucson, Ariz., were held Saturday morning in the Chapel of Mayflower Home. For the past year she had made her home in Tucson, with her son-in-law and daughter, Mr. and Mrs. Wallace Gooch.

Born Ethel Cook in Atlantic, Ia., July 20, 1888, she graduated from Villisca High School and attended Oberlin College Conservatory, completing the two-year course in public school music. Mrs. Eddy taught in public schools for a number of years.

In December, 1911, she was married to the Rev. A. L. Eddy. Mr. and Mrs. Eddy served Congregational churches in South Dakota, Ohio, Iowa, Illinois, and Wisconsin. The couple had two daughters.

After the death of her husband, Mrs. Eddy came to Grinnell to retire. She was an active member of the Congregational church and choir, and will be remembered for her leadership in community singing and her part-time assistance in the office at the Mayflower Home.

Survivors include her two daughters, Frances of Istanbul, Turkey, and Mrs. Gooch of Tucson, two grandsons, Frederick and Theodore Gooch, and three great grandchildren.
