Noah Edwards, 92, of Grinnell died Monday, Dec. 20, at Grinnell Regional Medical Center.

Funeral services were conducted Thursday morning at Ashland Baptist Church, Ashland, Mo., with the Rev. Jim West officiating. Burial was in Nashville Church Cemetery.
