## Former Resident Dies In Colorado

Funeral services for Mr. Garland E. (Tom) Eichhorn of 2718 W. Colorado Ave., Colorado Springs, Colo., were conducted at 2 p.m. Tuesday at the Blunt Funeral Home with the Rev. Philip L. Green of the First Methodist Church officiating.

Burial was at Fairview Cemetery.
