

E. A. Elliott Ex-Carpenter Here, Dies

He Died Sept. 20, 1954

Edgar Arthur Elliott, retired Grinnell carpenter, died Monday afternoon, Sept. 20, at a rest home, following a five-year illness. He was 76 years old.

Funeral services were held this afternoon, Thursday, at Smith Funeral Home with Rev. John DeLong officiating. Burial was at Rock Creek cemetery in Jasper county.

Mr. Elliott had resided practically his entire lifetime in the Grinnell community. Born in Rock Creek township in Jasper county he was the son of Elisha and Mary Quillen Elliott. He was born September 23, 1877, and lacked three days of observing his 77th birthday.

He was married at Oskaloosa to Margaret Faircloth on October 9, 1900. He was a member of Victor Grange west of Grinnell.

Surviving are two sons, Wilbur D., of Grinnell and Harold Edgar of Minneapolis, Minn.; one daughter, Mrs. Grace Marie Robbins of Grinnell; and a sister, Mrs. Lulu Parmley of Glenflora, Wis.
