Funeral Held Sunday For Gilbert Elliott

Funeral services were held Sunday afternoon for Gilbert Elliott of Deep River at the Steffy Funeral Home with the Rev. John Hansel officiating.

Interment was in Golden Rod Cemetery, Deep River. Casket bearers were: Bert Ross, Lowell Wolf, Cecil Elliott, Claudis Axtell, Kenneth Thorpe and Warren Stevenson.

Gilbert, son of Evaline and Noble Elliott, was born near Deep River on Aug. 24, 1886 and died at his home Thursday, March 3. He was 79.
