Wayne Elliott, 85, of Gilman died Monday, Sept. 10, at Grinnell General Hospital.

Funeral services were conducted Thursday afternoon in the Estel-Perrin-Avey Funeral Home chapel in Marshalltown, with the Rev. Steve Miller, pastor of the Gilman United Church of Christ, officiating. Burial was in Rose Hill Memorial Gardens, Marshalltown.

The son of Hezekiah and Carrie Quakenbush Elliott, he was born Sept. 27, 1904, in Fredricksburg, Ind. He received his education in the Collins schools.

He was married on Nov. 24, 1925, to Pearl Collins in Collins. The couple lived in Collins where Mr. Elliott was employed as a farmhand until 1927 when they moved to Illinois where he was a self-employed truck driver. In 1941 the couple moved to Marshalltown where Mr. Elliott was employed at Fisher Governor and Nash Finch, then moved to Gilman in 1946 where he worked at the Farmers Cooperative until retiring in 1969.
