John Ellis, son of William and Bridget Ellis, was born May 24, 1859 in the Corick on Shannon, Ireland. After suffering for some time with poor health he passed away at St. Francis Hospital Monday, February 27, 1928, having reached the fine old age of 68 years, 9 months and 3 days.
