Glen Elscott, 70, of Sully died Monday, Nov. 2, at Mercy Hospital Medical Center in Des Moines.

Funeral services were conducted Thursday at the First Reformed Church in Sully, with the Revs. Ralph Menning and Donald Woogie officiating. Burial was in Sully Cemetery, with the Van Dyk-Duven Funeral Home of Pella in charge of arrangements.

The son of John and Maggie Brand Elscott, he was born May 7, 1922, near Taintor. He attended Case rural school.

On Sept. 19, 1946, he was married to Verna Jean Vander Beek in Sully. The couple farmed near Taintor until 1952, then moved to the Sully area and farmed until retiring in 1981. They moved to Sully in 1984.

Mr. Elscott was a member of the Sully First Reformed Church. He had served on the Lynnville-Sully Community School Board and on the boards of the Sully Cooperative, Sully Telephone Association and Sully Cemetery Association.

He is survived by his wife; two daughters, Phyllis DeVries and Francene Reel, both of Prairie City; four sons, Merlyn of Lynnville and Jerry, Bryce and Dean of Sully; 15 grandchildren; five sisters, Jennie Geurts of Lynnville, Ellen Van Zante and Grace Renaud of Pella, and Gladys Renaud and Irene Verploeg of Sully.
