

## Mr. Engelbarts Rites Tuesday<sup>7/30/47</sup>

Louis R. Engelbarts, 92, of Rte. 2, Malcom, died Sunday morning at Grinnell General Hospital, following an extended illness.

The son of Engelbart and Anna Rankin Engelbarts, he was born Jan. 24, 1880, in Germany. He came to the United State with his parents at the age of 2, and they settled in Illinois, later moving to Jones County in the Monticello area where he received his education in the rural schools.

He was married to Julia Grabenstein Feb. 2, 1910, and she preceded him in death Feb. 1, 1948. The couple farmed in Pleasant Township in the Ewart community all their married life.

Survivors include one son, Earl Engelbarts of Malcom; his grandchildren, Gene of Malcom, Mrs. Richard (Bonieta) Young of Denver, Colo., and Barbara, Carl, Roger, and Dennis, all at home; and two great-grandchildren, Christopher and Heather Young of Denver. He was preceded in death by his parents, his wife, a great-grandson, Shannon Young; his sisters, Johanna, Marie, Anchen, and Emma; and his brothers, Benhard, Fredrick, Martin, and Ernest.
