Friday Services For Horace Ent, Former Resident

Former Grinnell resident Horace W. Ent, 82, succumbed on Tuesday evening at a Des Moines hospital.

Mr. Ent lived in Grinnell for many years where he was employed as a roofing contractor. He moved to Des Moines about two years ago.

Funeral services will be held Friday afternoon at 2:00 from the James-Schalinske Funeral Home with Rev. C. E. Kingsley, pastor of the First Baptist church, officiating. Mrs. Kathleen Heffner will furnish organ music.

Serving as pallbearers will be Paul Worcester, Geo. Hargrave, Paul Jantzen, Harold Hinegardner, Clark Wilson, and Marvin Bergstresser. Interment will be in Hazelwood cemetery.

The son of John and Helen Stevenson Ent, he was born on Sept. 3, 1877, at Dillsboro, Ind. As a young man he moved to the Grinnell community where he was united in marriage with Elizabeth Benson in 1904. She preceded him in death in 1949.

Mr. Ent was a member of the First Baptist church of Grinnell and the Knights of Pythias.

He is survived by his daughter, Mrs. Don (Helen) Thompson of Des Moines with whom he had made his home the past two years, two granddaughters, and three great grandchildren. Also surviving are a brother, James Ent, and a sister, Mrs. Jennie Patterson, both of Cincinnati, Ohio.

Besides his wife, he was preceded in death by his parents, three sisters, two brothers, and a stepson, Sam Tucker.
