Karrie Lynn Everist, 20, of Indianola, formerly of Brooklyn and a native of Grinnell, died Tuesday, May 11, of complications from cystic fibrosis at University of Minnesota Hospital in Minneapolis.

Memorial services were conducted Saturday at Grace United Methodist Church in Brooklyn, with the Rev. Kalen Fristad officiating.

She was the daughter of Ron and Connie Everist of Burnsville, Minn. She was born March 27, 1973, in Grinnell. She was a 1991 graduate of BGM High School and had completed her sophomore year at Simpson College, where she met her fiancé, Steve Phillips.

She was a member of the Grace United Methodist Church and Alpha Chi Omega sorority at Simpson. In high school she was a member of the National Honor Society, junior and senior class president, Kiwanis Student of the Month, a cheerleader and a participant in band and vocal music. She was an All-State speech performer her junior year and was the D.A.R. recipient in 1991.
