Lynnville Woman, Mary Eyfink, 95, Dies This Morning

LYNNVILLE (Special) —Mrs. Mary Eyfink, who would have been 95 Jan. 16th, died this morning (Monday) at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Guy Vander Pol, west of here.

She had made her home with her daughter for the past three years. Mrs. Eyfink had been active until suffering a stroke last Thursday.

Funeral services will be held at 1 p.m. Thursday from the Pella Garden chapel. Pallbearers, all grandsons, will be Delmar Vander Pol, Rolland and Ernest Eyfink, and Willis, Wayne, and Dale Van Wyk. Burial will be at Graceland cemetery near Pella.

The daughter of Gerrit and Maggie DeJong Van Genderen, she was born near Pella. In 1894, she was united in marriage with Ryan Eyfink, who preceded her in death.

Survivors include two daughters, Mrs. Tennis Van Wyk of Monroe and Mrs. Maggie Vander Pol of Lynnville; two sons, John of Lynnville and Gerritt of Pella; 11 grandchildren, 24 great grandchildren, and two great, great grandchildren.
