Troy Leon Fain Succumbs Friday In New Jersey

Troy Leon Fain, 55, of Grinnell, died Friday at a Bayonne, N.J., hospital of injuries received Oct. 1st in an accident in that city.

Funeral services were held this afternoon (Monday) at the Methodist church in Scranton, Iowa.

Mr. Fain, an employee of Miracle Equipment Co. of Grinnell, was injured in a work accident while making a delivery at the Naval supply station in Bayonne.
