W. A. Faircloth was born at Winston-Salem, North Carolina, April 13, 1857, and died at Montezuma, June 27, 1929, at the age of 78 years, 2 months, and 14 days.

He was the youngest of the eleven children of Jacob and Louisa Cartright Faircloth.

When a very young child, he with his father's family moved to Iowa, settling near Grinnell, where most of the remainder of his life was spent. For several years of his later life he lived with his brother, John and wife, Sadie Hall Faircloth. After their deaths, he lived by himself, later going to Montezuma, where he died.

W. Ashbury Faircloth was an old pioneer and lived on a farm. His last days were full of suffering and his death came as a relief.
