## Amos Falkinburg, Lifetime Malcom Resident, Dies

Amos Falkinburg, 94, lifelong resident of the Malcom community, died Tuesday morning at a local hospital.

Funeral services will be held Friday at 2 p. m. from the United Presbyterian church at Malcom with the pastor, the Rev. James T. Robinson officiating. Vocal music will be provided by Mr. and Mrs. Keith Stahl, accompanied by Mrs. Nellie Farley at the organ.

Serving on the flower committee will be Mrs. Virgil Taylor and Mrs. Donald Griffith. Pallbearers will be Lester Schneckloth, Jr., P. G. Varnum, Lester Baltisberger, Donald Griffith, Virgil Taylor and Wayne McClure.

Interment will be in Ivy Hill cemetery at Malcom with James-Schalinske Funeral Home in charge of arrangements.

The son of James and Isabelle Smalley Falkinburg, he was born in a log cabin south of Malcom on January 19th, 1868. He attended the rural schools of that community and farmed on the home place for some time.

He was united in marriage with Emma Francis on Sept. 14, 1895, at Malcom. She preceded him in death on Oct. 7th, 1959. They farmed north of Malcom for a number of years and after their retirement lived in Malcom for 43 years. For the past three years Mr. Falkinburg had made his home with Katherine Cummings in Grinnell.

He was a member of the United Presbyterian church of Malcom.

Besides his wife, he was preceded in death by his parents; a sister, Mrs. Stella May Nutting; and three brothers, Harry, Eugene and Jay.
