Elsie Estelle Ferneau, youngest daughter of Sarah and Walker Ferneau, was born in Montezuma, Iowa, October 27th, 1885, and departed this life at her home in Deep River, December 13th, 1928, after a brief illness.

Her early life was spent in and around Montezuma, where she attended school until her parents moved to Malcom, in which locality she attended school and finished her education.

She was united in marriage to Earl H. Farhney of Deep River, January 29th, 1910, and they have since made their home in or near Deep River.

She united with the Church of Christ at Deep River soon after her marriage, in which church she was always a willing worker, doing her part in everything. Her life was full of noble sacrifice as she was always forgetful of self in her interest in others.
