Florence E. Ferguson, 87, of the Mayflower died of a heart ailment Monday, Jan. 29.

A memorial service will be conducted at 4 p.m. Thursday in the Activity Center of the Mayflower, with the Rev. Robert Molsberry, pastor of the United Church of Christ - Congregational, officiating. Pianist will be Norman Goodbrod.
