

## Louis A. Fleener

Louis A. Fleener, 60, of Eldora, formerly of Grinnell, died of cancer Thursday, July 6, at Mercy Medical Center - North Iowa, Mason City.

Funeral services were conducted Saturday at the First Congregational United Church of Christ in Eldora, with the Revs. Corey Larson and Anne Lippincott officiating. Burial was at Chester Cemetery near Grinnell.

He was born Feb. 14, 1940, in Grinnell to Arthur W. and Marjory V. Hafkey Fleener. He was a 1958 graduate of Grinnell High School and later graduated from Gates Business College in Waterloo.
