

Imo Foster dies in Tennessee

Word has been received here of the death of Imo R. Foster on about May 17 in Pleasant Hill, Tenn. Death was attributed to cancer.

She and her late husband, the Rev. Virgil Foster, lived in Grinnell from 1946 to 1951 while Dr. Foster was director of Christian education for the Iowa Congregational Christian Conference. The Fosters then moved to Chicago and later to New York City while Dr. Foster served as an editor for the National Council of Churches. He died in 1970, and about a year later Mrs. Foster moved to the retirement center in Pleasant Hill.

She had been a director of Christian education in local churches in Eugene, Ore., and St. Louis, Mo., before their marriage. She wrote occasional magazine articles on the arts.

She is survived by a sister.
