

Lucinda Foster services held

Lucinda Louise Foster, 86, of the Mayflower Home died April 11 at the home.

Funeral services were conducted at 10 a.m. Wednesday at the Adams Funeral Home in Ames, with the Rev. Joe M. Hendrixson of the United Church of Christ-Congregational of Ames officiating. Burial was in the Ames Municipal Cemetery.

The daughter of Frank and Tima Grove Foster, she was born on July 30, 1900, in Kelley, Iowa. She lived in Story County for most of her life, moving to Grinnell in July 1965. She was a 1917 graduate of Ames High School and had attended the I.B.U. business school in Des Moines.

She worked as a bookkeeper in the Kelley Bank and in the city clerk's office in Ames. She

had also worked in Washington, D.C., during World War II and for 40 years was a secretary at Iowa State University. She retired in 1965.

She was a member of the United Church of Christ-Congregational in both Ames and Grinnell and the National Federation of Business and Professional Women's Clubs, holding numerous offices in that organization at both the state and local levels.

There are no immediate survivors.

A memorial service was conducted at 10:30 a.m. Thursday in Denison Chapel at the Mayflower Home, with the Rev. Philip Ramstad, pastor of the Grinnell United Church of Christ-Congregational, officiating.
