CLINTON W. FOWLER JR.

Funeral Services for Clinton W. Fowler, 88, of Estherville, Iowa, were held at 11 a.m., Tuesday, March 18, 1986, in the Nevenhoven Funeral Home, Brooklyn. Mr. Fowler, a former resident of Brooklyn, died Friday, March 14, 1986, in his home in Estherville.

Rev. Raymond D. Moore, Pastor of the Grace United Methodist Church, Brooklyn, officiated. The organist was Mrs. Sybil Kelley. Honorary Casket-Bearers were Bert Gillette, Edwin Montgomery, Edgar Buchenau, and Floyd McAllister. Casket-Bearers were Jack Hall, Gerald Read, Gerald Hall, Glenn J. Kriegel, Roger Gritsch, and Keith Brannian. Interment was in the IOOF Cemetery, Brooklyn.

Clinton Wells Fowler, son of Clinton W. and Mary Armstrong Fowler, was born January 3, 1898, in Brooklyn, and died Friday, March 14, 1986, in his home in Estherville, Iowa, having attained the age of 88 years, 2 months, and 11 days.

He was united in marriage to Grace Hicks in Brooklyn on April 12, 1922. He lived all of his life in the Brooklyn Community until in 1983 when they moved to Estherville to be near their daughter, Mrs. Phyllis Montgomery.

Mr. Fowler was president of the Poweshiek County Savings Bank of Brooklyn until his retirement in 1975. He was a veteran of World War I.

Mr. Fowler was a member of the Grace United Methodist Church, Corinthian Lodge No. 174 AF & AM, Francis Gallagher American Legion Post No. 294, Iowa Bankers Association, a former member of the Brooklyn Commercial Club, and had served as secretary of the Brooklyn School Board.

Surviving are his wife, Grace; one son, Phillip Fowler of Laramie, Wyo.; his daughter, Phyllis, Mrs. Arthur Montgomery of Estherville; five grandchildren; and six great-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his parents and three brothers, Fred, Harry, and Bill.
